



## New housing in Kirkheaton

After a long period of inactivity there has now been two new planning applications for housing within Kirkheaton.

The first is for 42 houses to be constructed on the old Broadhead and Graves mill site on Shop Lane with a further 6 sited at the top of Orchard Road on its old garage and parking site.

Also a full planning application for 57 houses on the greenfield site on Cockley Hill Lane has been submitted to Kirklees. This proposal seems to have divided into two development parcels. Parcel 1 consisting of 57 houses is the subject of the current application. Parcel 2 plans for 38 more houses to be built at a future date.



The old mill site will have 22 x 2 bedroom houses. Four of these will be 3 storey. A further 6 will be 4 bedroom houses and the rest are 3 beds. A pedestrian access to Bankfield Lane will be created at the top of the site. There will also be hedgehog access holes installed in each boundary fence. Ten of the houses are identified as “affordable”.

The current proposal at Cockley Hill is for: 8 x 2 bedroom terraced, 35 x 3 bedroom semis/terrace and 14 x 4 bedroom detached. Eleven of these houses are identified as being “affordable”.

All houses will have an electric charging point.

While the design statements mention the diversity of housing types and materials in the area there doesn't seem to be any information about the building materials to be used.

**Landfill Site Update**  
Since they took over the landfill site in 2020 Compton's have been active in finding out about their recent purchase.

*A team of ecologist has been on site recording all the wildlife and their activities. They are also checking the ponds to ensure that the water is not polluted and that the great crested newts are thriving.*

*The central area is now fenced off to allow several highland cattle and their calves to roam.*

*A small area in the middle has some geese and ducks, and a family of three pygmy goats.*

*They have also asked the Environment Agency and Kirklees Planning to permanently remove the dumping of municipal waste from the site licence. This will ensure that the area cannot be used as a dump for domestic waste without going through planning again.*

*Crompton's are keen to work with the village to protect the wildlife and expect to reinstate liaison meetings with residents soon.*

Please consider leaving your lawn uncut so the flowers can bloom there, then, if you like the look and the added interest it brings to your garden, select areas to leave long until the autumn. Some people mow paths through the longer grass which gives somewhere for the blackbirds to hunt for worms.

We have handed out over 500 packs of wildflower seeds to villagers. Now we can look forward to seeing little areas of

blooms all over the village. Please share photos of your results on our Facebook group.

Have you seen a hedgehog or their signs such as tiny cigar shaped, blackish poos on your lawn? If so, make sure it is easy for them to get in and out of your garden as they range over a big area each night in search of those pesky slugs. A CD sized hole under your fence will do it.

We are planning an activities day in the Orchard on Saturday 4th September. Bring the family and help build a bug hotel or bat box and even build your own bird box to take away (limited supplies – first come first served!). There will be

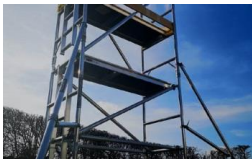


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# YT Trustee retires
