## Rock Solid Effort! Tidying the Trough

*If you have driven down Shop Lane recently, you might have been curious about activity going on around the old water trough for horses, near the end of Orchard Road. Sean Rogers explains:*

What began as a simple effort to improve visibility when turning left out of Orchard Road onto Shop Lane quickly blossomed into something much more meaningful. It started with a single clip to clear the view and a friendly chat with Diane from Doctors Row about adding a few flowers to brighten the corner. That's when I noticed the neglected dry-stone wall and, as someone who's always loved the character and craftsmanship of dry stone walls, the project suddenly took on a whole new life.



From basic weeding and strimming, it evolved into a hands-on journey of learning how to repair and rebuild dry stone walls under the expert guidance of Robin and Justin. Their knowledge and patience were invaluable, and the transformation wouldn't have been possible without them.

This was truly a team effort. Alan, Diane, Robin, Justin, John, Jake, Jack, and Aunt Sarah all rolled up their sleeves and got stuck in. A special thanks to Dave for lending me his strimmer, and to the skilled friends from Doctors Row who brought their Stihl saw expertise. We're also deeply grateful to those who donated stone, and to Thomas Crompton for donating and delivering some top soil; your generosity helped shape the heart of this project.



Of course, no community effort is complete without good food and drink. We were kept well-fuelled by an endless supply of homemade cakes, scones, and biscuits, and on those hot summer days a cold beer was just the ticket.

Now, the area around the trough is nearing its final stage, and it's looking better than ever. Neighbours have given flowers to be planted, adding a personal and heartfelt touch. Thank you to Kirkheaton's "20% for Wildlife" group for their donation of wildflower seed; we can't wait to see them bloom and bring even more colour and life to the area.

What started as a small act of tidying up has grown into a celebration of community, craftsmanship, and care. The corner of Orchard Road and Shop Lane is now not just safer, but a place of pride and beauty for everyone who passes by.

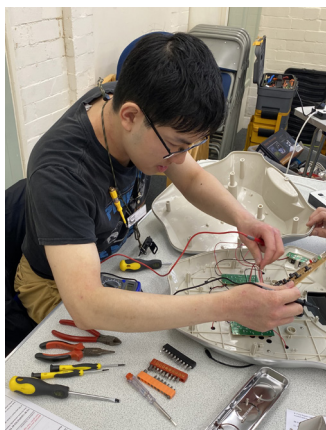

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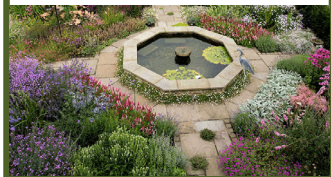
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## **Linthwaite Brass Band at Kirkheaton**

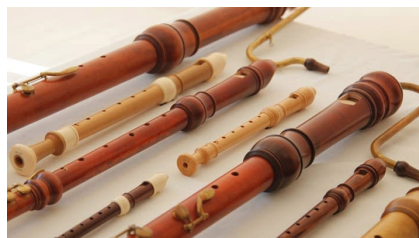


## **Kirkheaton Recorders**

Trish Mellor, chair of Yetton Together, thanked volunteers for their vital contributions; delivering the community magazine, baking and serving at the coffee shop and improving the village environment with seasonal planters, wild flower areas and maintenance of the community orchard, to name just a few. "Volunteers are the backbone of Yetton Together," she said. "Yetton Together would be nothing without them!"

Three long-serving volunteers, Lesley Ingleby, Marilyn Eastwood, and Jean Broscombe, were honoured with special awards and short breaks for two, courtesy of Room to Reward, a charity that recognises outstanding community service.

The volunteers enjoyed a wonderful spread and a glass of prosecco. It was a lovely afternoon as people chatted together about their roles and recognised they were all part of a wider group, all helping to improve the village in some way. Everyone received a goody bag with a thank-you card and a YT-branded water bottle.

One volunteer summed up the event: "The benefits of volunteering work both ways. Keeping busy with all the activities at the community centre and the lovely friendships I've formed there have made such a difference to my life in the ten years since my partner died."

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## 100 Pints\* and Still Counting

Kirkheaton resident, Michael Bowyer, recently donated his 100th pint of blood at the ripe old age of 83! Michael has been a blood donor for 52 years, attending blood donor sessions which have been held at the United Church, then later at Moldgreen and more recently in Huddersfield. By 2013 he had donated 75 pints and has continued to donate on average two further units per year since then, despite having operations in the meantime to replace two hips and one knee!

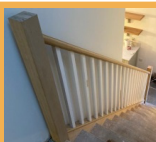
As one of only 8% of the population with O negative blood type Michael's donations are in great demand as they can be given to anyone in an emergency or when a person's blood type is unknown.

Did you know?

- Only 7% of the UK population give blood.
- 4,300 blood donations are needed every day on average to meet the needs of hospitals.
- 140,000 new donors are needed each year.
- More young people aged 17-35 are needed as donors.
